### Minutes

RESOLVED, that the Board approve the minutes from the July 28, 2009 regular meeting. Motion by Director Raines, seconded by Director Sosa. Motion passes 5-0.

### Treasurer's Report

RESOLVED, that the Board approve the Treasurer's Report showing total current assets of \$729,010.78 as of August 8, 2009. Motion by Director Kirby, seconded by Director McAnelly. Motion passes 5-0.

### Executive Director's Report

Executive Director, Warren Ketteman provided a synopsis of activities and updates including: the Buda-Kyle Higher Education Committee seeking 16-20 individuals to serve on a steering committee to prepare us for an in-district ACC vote; a recent meeting with Chief Huckaby and City of Buda representatives concerning the elimination of ESD #8 sales tax authority in the ETJ once the City annexes the property – Buda Fire Department stands to lose \$10,000.00 per month; and a meeting with Larry Niemann, owner of the 10 acre portion of the dump site, and his new planning firm – Mr. Niemann plans to move forward with development of the property using dynamic compaction.

### Funds for Buda Sportsplex Amenities and Yearly Maintenance Costs

Finance Director Sarah Mangham and Assistant Parks Director Jake Eason spoke in regard to the City's request for assistance from Buda EDC to fund a portion of maintenance costs and purchase certain amenities for Buda Sportsplex. Ms. Mangham and Mr. Eason assured the Board their request for \$48,000.00 will be used for field maintenance only and will be a one-time request for such funds. Mr. Eason stated the fields would be spike aerated by Labor Day, top dressing would be completed in October and fertilization would occur each quarter. These steps would be needed in order to make the fields presentable.

RESOLVED, that the Board approve the EDC to make a one-time contribution to the City Parks Department for maintenance of the Sportsplex soccer and softball fields for the 2009-2010 year subject to receipt of maintenance schedule with costs not to exceed \$48,000. Motion by Director Raines, seconded by Director Kirby. Motion passes 5-0.

### Executive Director Employment Contract

RESOLVED, that the Board adopt the Executive Directors employment contract pursuant to committee recommendations. Motion by Director Sosa, seconded by Director Kirby. Motion passes 5-0.
